# Flag policy - SPCB(2020)paper 1

- 4. The SPCB discussed the matter of the European Flag being flown at Holyrood. The flag was flown in recognition of the UK's membership of the EU. Following the UK's decision to leave the EU, the SPCB agreed the European Flag would no longer be flown on a daily basis at the Scottish Parliament. In reaching this decision, the SPCB took account of its responsibility to maintain and protect the neutrality of the Scottish Parliament as an institution.
- 5. The SPCB also agreed that the European flag could be flown on Europe Day as a mark of the UK's continued ties with that body. The flag-flying policy would be amended to reflect these decisions.

6. The SPCB had a further discussion on options considered as part of the review and clarified how other areas highlighted could be taken forward in the future.

7. The SPCB agreed to support Scotland's bid to host the 8th Parliament of the World's Religions in 2021 or 2022.
