Remote voting

 The SPCB noted an update on progress with developing a new remote voting system. Testing had gone well and guidance had been prepared for MSPs. Following discussion, the SPCB agreed that the new system should be introduced when Parliament resumed business the following week. The Presiding Officer would update the Business Bureau and seek agreement later that day.

Access arrangements - update

2. Following the First Minister's latest statement, the SPCB noted that Scotland was still in Phase 3 of the Scottish Government's roadmap, with working from home, where possible, still the default position. Access to Holyrood would continue to be restricted to business days other than in exceptional circumstances. A further



update on access arrangements would be issued to all building users the next day (Friday 7 August).

3. The next Scottish Government review was scheduled for 30 August. Officials would continue to monitor guidance issued by the Scottish Government and update the SPCB accordingly.

4. The next meeting of the SPCB was scheduled for Thursday 3 September 2020 although additional meetings may be arranged in the interim should the need arise.
