Acting Ethical Standards Commissioner's Business Case for Additional Staff – Paper 63

 The SPCB considered a business case for additional staff submitted by the Acting Ethical Standards Commissioner. This was to address issues raised in the Auditor General for Scotland's Section 22 report "The 2020/21 audit of the Commissioner for Ethical Standards in Public Life in Scotland". The additional funding requested would address capacity concerns, improve resilience, and assist the office in meeting its key performance targets. 2. The SPCB approved the full business case - totalling £367,000 for a full year - which included a request for 7.4 additional members of staff and to regrade two existing posts. The SPCB further agreed that contingency funding would be available to fund any appointments made in advance of the new financial year.
